. not only was possible to go behind the courtyard walls to penetrate the stone front, but the subterranean passage was lighted with a perfectly transparent oil lamp, and the light in the long gallery illuminated the walls of the passage, walled on both sides with rows of the same kind of stone blocks, but with vacant spaces where formerly stood rude buildings and great rocks, tumbled down by the torrent, the soil of which had been washed by rains from their height into the passage, where its water had deposited the ochre and yellow earth with which the wall was covered, which was less readily soluble in the water, and consequently sank in it with more difficulty than the stone. The place was not less than two miles from the palace, and at a considerable distance from the river. The course of the water ran in a circle around the castle, and fell finally into the great lake, with which it was partially embayed, and which filled a large part of the plain beyond the castle walls. The arched passage, leading from the castle to the place of confinement, was closed at the upper end with the same kind of stone blocks, where the walls were quite smooth, and bore neither inscription nor carving, and had doubtless at some remote period been coated with lime. The hollow space under the court was, as already observed, well lighted from a lamp, and by this light, and the little light which the twinkling of the stars alone afforded, she perceived a large area paved with stone, perhaps with glass, but only in the upper part, which she thought was the great saloon of the castle, where doubtless the prince and his nobles and friends of distinction assembled in their company, as, most probably, was now the case, for the castle did not appear to be inhabited, and no person appeared when she climbed the wall to look round. There was a small door, which, probably, was the entrance to the privy, for she could see the top of a box of wood, and there was likewise a similar one in the stone wall; the rest of the space was hollowed out, and its sides were left rough and uneven, and down this rough surface she dropped with a sensation of sudden fear, which made her feel, although not a particle of rain had fallen. The water, from the steepness of the place and the depth of the excavation, ran quickly over the whole bottom, and the foam it made on the smooth stones was sparkling in the moonbeams, as she sunk into its
