But on Monday, we got an answer to that question. If reports are to be believed, the Patriots are willing to part with a draft pick to land running back Alfred Blue. According to NESN's Mike Reiss, the Patriots are willing to give up their fourth-round pick in exchange for Blue, the 247Sports' No. 14-ranked running back. Mike Reiss reports New England will give up its 4th rounder for RB Alfred Blue. Pats are ranked #8 in running back by ESPN — Mike Reiss (@NEESPN) August 24, 2014 Reiss reported earlier this month that the Texans had interest in trading for the fifth-year running back. He said at that time that the Patriots were not willing to part with a draft pick to acquire Blue, but an earlier report indicated that the Patriots had inquired about his availability. With the trade of Foster, and the signing of Knowshon Moreno to a one-year deal, the Patriots have downgraded their depth at running back from what it had been earlier this year. Blue has been impressive during his four years in college. He ran for 1,507 yards and 20 touchdowns during his final year at Oklahoma. He also caught 29 passes for 508 yards and two touchdowns. He averaged 4.8 yards per carry in his final season. His speed and ability to take it the distance would seem to make him a perfect fit in the Patriots' offense. As we mentioned earlier, he'd be a nice addition to the team's depth at running back. We'll have to wait and see if the Patriots will make this trade, but it would make a lot of sense for them to do so.
